# Monday, July 24, 2017

Morning visit Cornell University. Campus Tour and Info Session (pending) at Cornell University —Cornell University is an American private Ivy League and federal landgrant research university located in Ithaca, New York. Founded in 1865 by Ezra Cornell and Andrew Dickson White, the university was intended to teach and make contributions in all fields of knowledge — from the classics to the sciences, and from the theoretical to the applied. These ideals, unconventional for the time, are captured in Cornell's motto, a popular 1865 Ezra Cornell quotation: "I would found an institution where any person can find instruction in any study." Since its founding, Cornell has been a co-educational, non-sectarian institution where admission has not been restricted by religion or race. The university is broadly organized into seven undergraduate colleges and seven graduate divisions at its main Ithaca campus, with each college and division defining its own admission standards and academic programs in near autonomy.

**9:30 AM** Morning visit to <u>Columbia University</u> for a campus tour & information session. (Pending availability) From a one-room classroom with one professor and eight students, Columbia University has grown to include more than 4,000 faculty members and 23,000 students. Over the years, 73 of Columbia's alumni and current or former faculty have received the Nobel Prize. Today Columbia is what President Lee Bollinger has called "the quintessential great urban university"—attracting students and faculty from 150 countries to engage with each other and with the cultural, scientific, and business enterprises that make New York City one of the most exciting cities in the world.

Afternoon, board the Statue ferry to visit the STATUE OF LIBERTY AND ELLIS ISLAND.



The Statue of Liberty Enlightening the World was a gift of friendship from the people of France to the people of the United States and is a universal symbol of freedom and democracy. The Statue of Liberty was dedicated on October 28, 1886, designated as a National Monument in 1924 and restored for her centennial on July 4, 1986. Ellis Island....America's Golden Door.....They came seeking freedom, opportunity, new lives. Over 12 million immigrants passed through the doors of Ellis Island between January 1, 1892 and November 1954, hoping to achieve the "American Dream". These people, and their descendants, have woven their way into the fabric of American life. They have helped create the America we know today.

Founded in 1701 in the <u>Colony of Connecticut</u>, the university is the third-oldest institution of <u>higher education</u> in the United States. Yale has produced many <u>notable alumni</u>, including five <u>U.S. presidents</u>, nineteen <u>U.S. Supreme Court Justices</u>, and several foreign <u>heads of state</u>. Yale University comprises three major academic components: <u>Yale College</u> (the undergraduate program), the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, and the professional

schools. In addition, Yale encompasses a wide array of centers and programs, libraries, museums, and administrative support offices. Approximately 11,250 students attend Yale.

Founded in 1764, it is a member of the Ivy League and is renowned for the quality of its teaching, research, and unique curriculum. Brown's three schools offer nearly 100 programs of study. The University adheres to a collaborative university-college model in which faculty are as committed to teaching as they are to research, embracing a curriculum that requires students to be architects of their education. Brown's campus is composed of 238 buildings and sits on 143 acres in Providence, the capital of Rhode Island.
